The Philippines

This month we ministered at a Pastor's Marriage Conference in Banaue, Philippines at the Noah's Ark Orphanage. Approximately 100 pastors came (men and women) from all over the area along with their spouses. The Laing's from Cambodia and Pastor Fred Middel from Crosslands Newmarket were also presenters. The pastors eagerly ate up the teaching and were full of questions. Culturally the Philippines is very different from other countries in South East Asia. A majority are Roman Catholic, divorce is illegal and yet, many marriages are falling apart. It was great to be able to be part of their lives for a few days, and encourage them to love Jesus first and then love each other whole heartedly. We were also honoured to minister at a Church in Manila.

NightLight and Interns

February was an exciting month at NightLight. 3 more of our women accepted Jesus, 12 were baptized in water at our annual retreat and 12 were baptized in the Holy Spirit at one of our morning devotions. As I explained what being baptized in the Holy Spirit meant, the girls hungrily came forward to receive. All who prayed to be filled were filled in a matter of minutes. As soon as they began to speak in tongues they then turned to the woman next to them who was still seeking and begin to pray for them to be filled. It was truly an exciting morning. It was amazing to see such child like faith which Jesus immediately rewarded with His Holy Spirit.
